Contracting Covid - 19 (From other people on-site)	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High	Social distancing. Reducing number of people on site. One-way system. Increased welfare. Increased Cleaning of welfare	Solo working. Adhere to site Rules.	High
Contracting Covid - 19 Toilets surfaces.	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High	Only two people to use the toilets at any one time. Increasing the cleaning of facilities. Toilet attendant to ensure compliance.	Wash hands before and after. Adhere to Site Rules	High
Contracting Covid - 19 Canteen surfaces.	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High	Setting tables far apart. Staggering breaks. Increasing the cleaning, before and after each group of people.	Make sure all allied operatives use the bins provided to leave the canteen free from rubbish. Wash hands before and after use. Adhere to site rules.	High
Contracting Covid - 19. Surfaces on site. i.e. handrails.	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High.	Site wide cleaning of all frequently touched surfaces.	Avoid contact where possible. Use gloves. Wipe surfaces clean.	High
Contracting Covid - 19. Access and egress points	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metre operatives.	High	Gate person to ensure there is no queues forming. Disable entry systems.	Always maintain 2m minimum distance.	High
Contracting Covid - 19. Scaffolding and MEWPs	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High	Ensure contractors only use their own equipment.	Only use your own scaffolding or Mobile Elevated Work Platform. Clean down before first use.	High
Contracting Covid - 19. Door handles/ buttons.	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High	Continual cleaning required. Disable entry systems and keep doorways open where possible.	Avoid contact if possible. Use gloves.	High
Contracting Covid - 19. Materials on site.	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High	Keep vigilant of other trades using materials to lean on.	Only touch your own materials. Only handle what you need. Use gloves.	High

People on site not following the safety procedures.	Everyone on the site	High	Enforce Rules and Immediately removed them from site and ban them.	Report failure to adhere to Main Contractor and if not actioned stand operatives down and remove from site. Site operatives to self-enforce with work mates and piers and report to line manager and Main Contractor if anyone is flouting the site rules and procedures	High
Travel to work.	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High	Provide additional parking. Provide hand cleaning points at site access points	Ask people to travel in alone. Try to use your own vehicle and avoid Public Transport	High
People with pre-existing medical condition i.e. asthma, bronchitis. That would make them vulnerable.	The individual	High		Pre-return to work Occupational Health Assessment. Do not let them return to work.	Low
People with family that are considered vulnerable.	The individual and their family.	High		Pre-Return to work Risk Assessment. Do not let them return to work.	Low.
Falling ill when on site.	Site operatives. Anyone who comes within 2 metres of operatives.	High	Keep Vigilant	Ask them if they are fit to go home themselves. Call emergency services	High
Injuries while Solo working.	Site Operatives	High	Keep Vigilant	Line manager to keep in regular contact with operatives.	Medium
