CDM 2015 – ACoP or not?

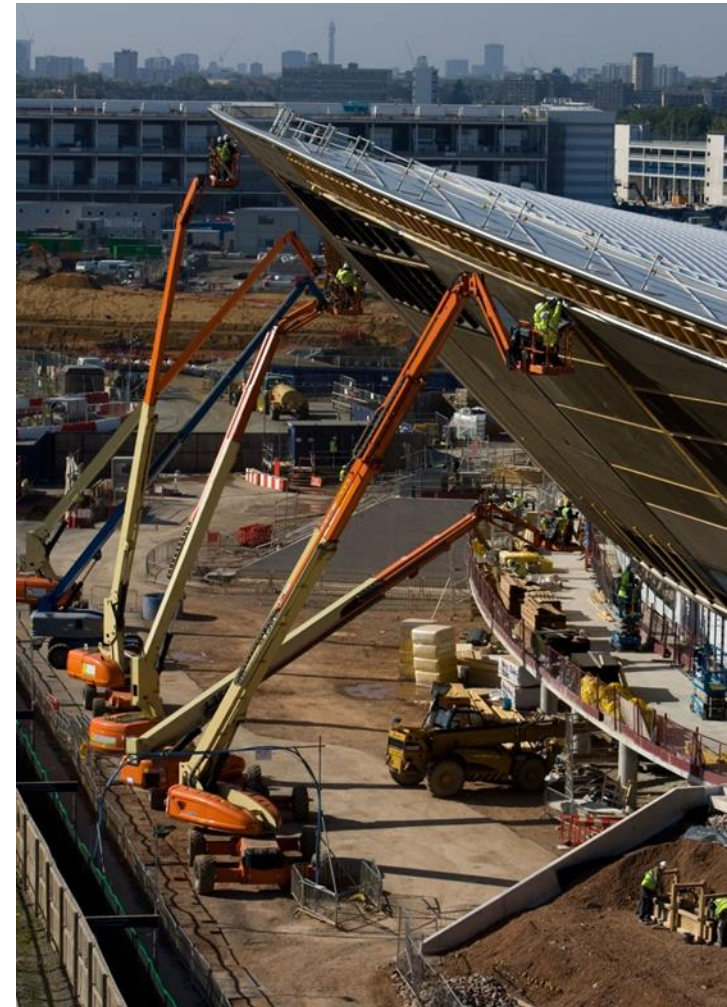
- During initial consultation on CDM 2015 proposals the question was asked whether an ACoP was needed
- C 70% said yes
- That was before the L series guidance, the 6 industry duty holder guides; smart app for H&S phase plan etc had been produced
- Though no further formal consultation was required, HSE has consulted with industry since the guidance came out
- General feeling is an ACoP is not now needed



CDM 2015 – ACoP or not?



- ACoP requires Secretary of State to sign it off, unlike guidance
- So need to be able to very much demonstrate it would add value
- If that is only added value in a small area, then why not additional guidance to cover any such gaps
- Paper to CONIAC. TUs strongly opposed
- Still to resolve issues and paper to HSE Board



Refurbishment initiative

- **Autumn refurbishment initiative**
- **Different from previous in that industry organisations more closely involved this time**
- **Liaison with relevant trade bodies, including FIS, to raise profile and see whether those bodies could identify common factors and offer advice to members**



Refurbishment initiative

- Number of inspections - 2274 (up 13%)
- Number of sites where NoCs served - 887 (up 28%)
- Number of sites where Notices served - 441 (up 23%)
- Number PN's – 432 (up 38%)
- Number IN's – 260 (up 11%)
- Number of NoCs – 983 (up 31%)

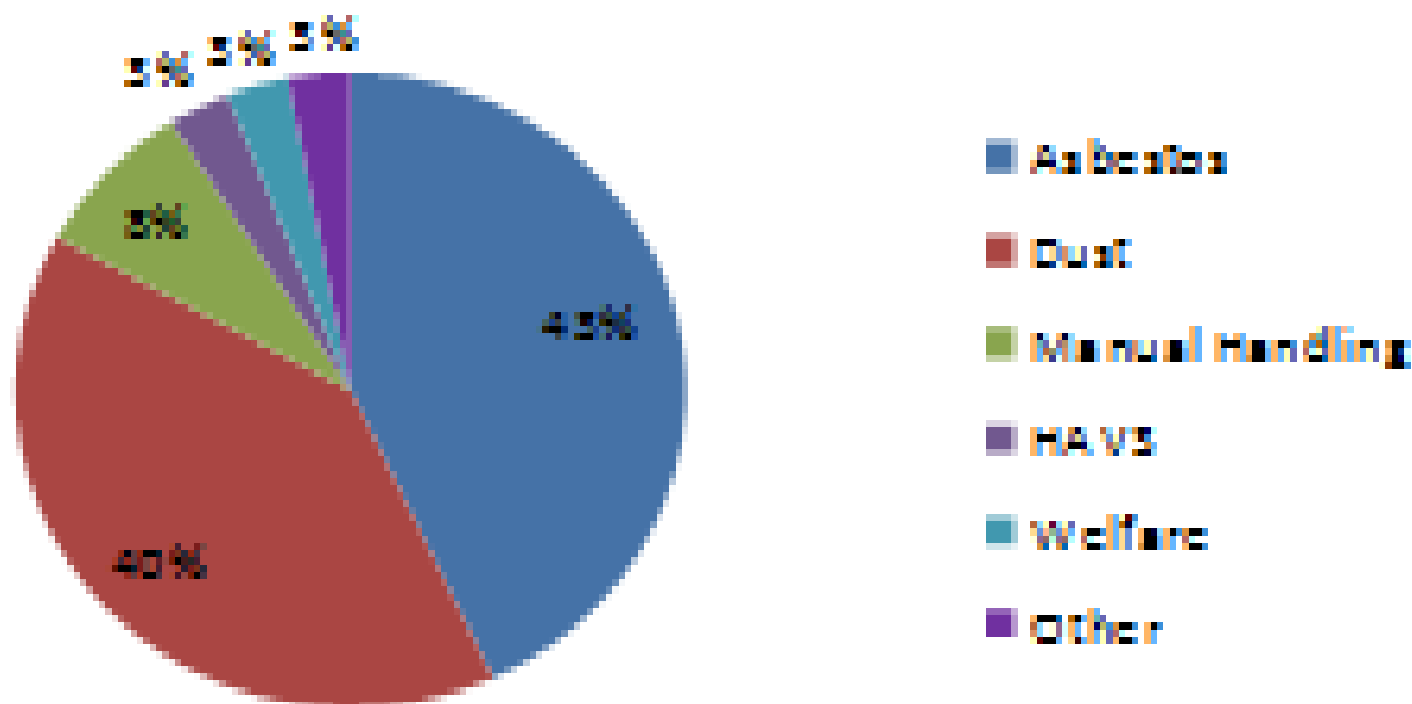
OH enforcement 2015

- Though no precise figures we can get some idea from initiatives (such as refurbishment)



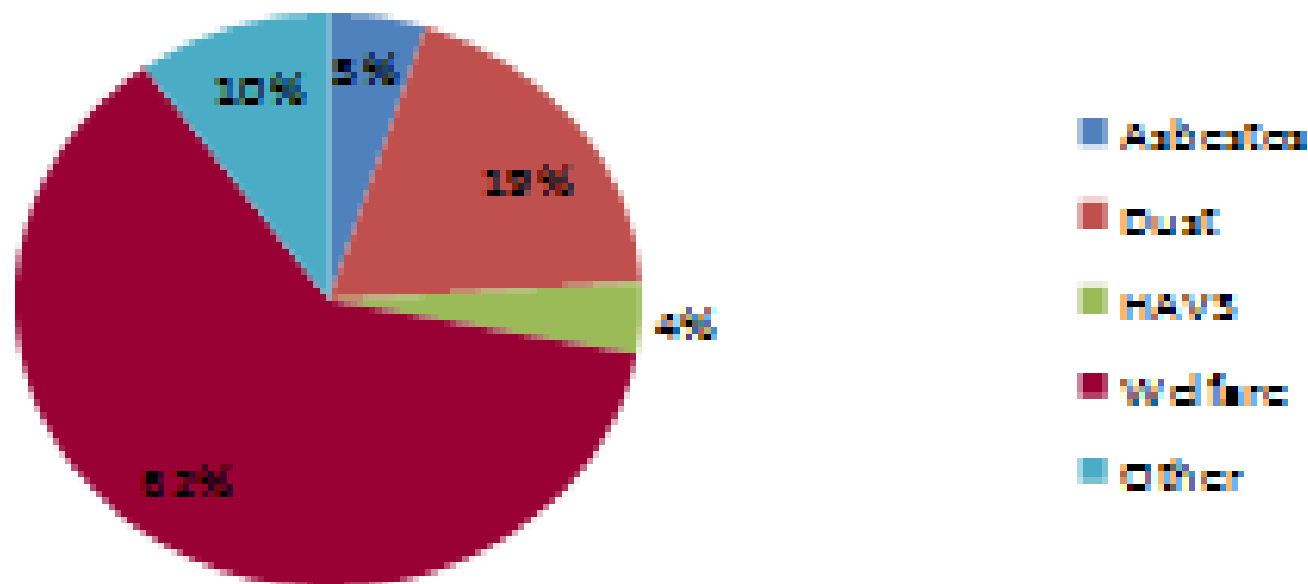
Refurbishment initiative 2015/16

Prohibition Notices

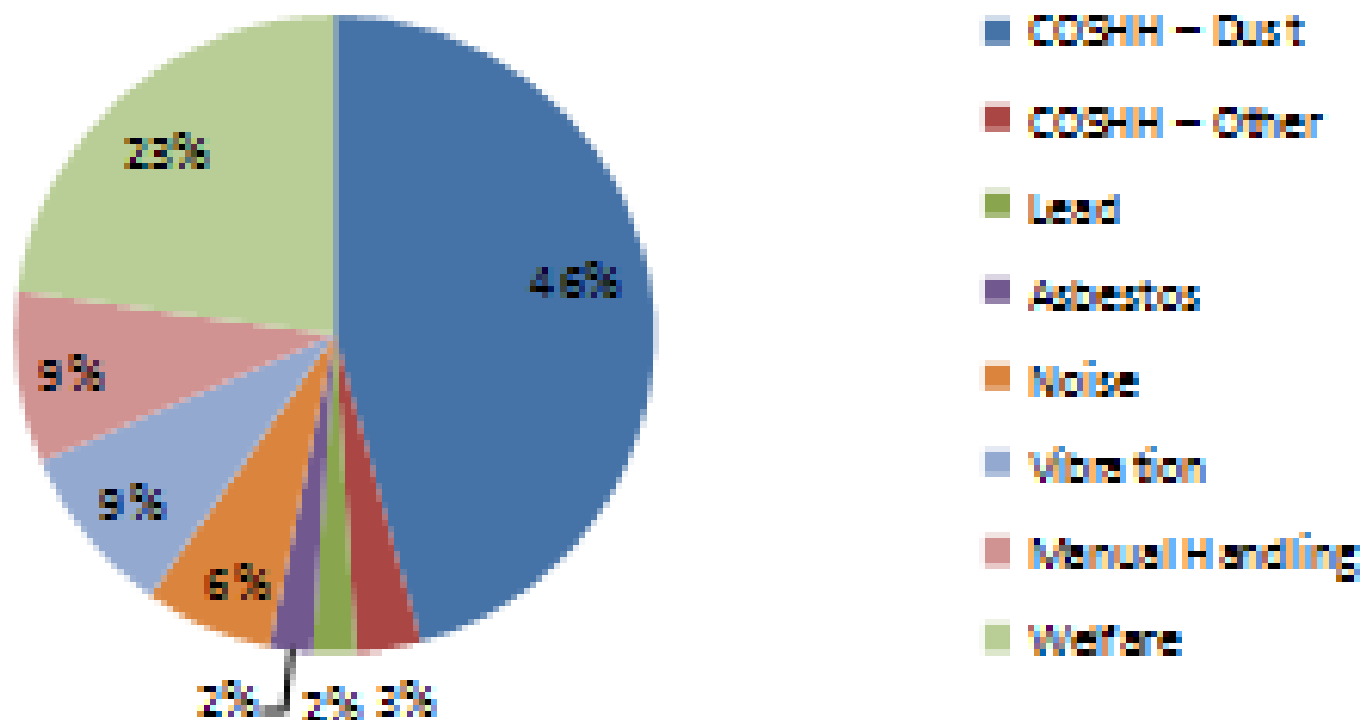
