#### WHAT IS DRYLINING?

Drylining (also referred to as drywall systems) is the lining of the internal structures of buildings such as walls, partitions and ceilings.

Plasterboard is attached to the internal faces, creating a smooth surface that finishes such as skim plaster or paint can be applied to directly.

An operative can specialise in drywall fixing or drywall finishing, or both.

### HOW DO I START?

#### SEVEN EASY STEPS FROM REGISTRATION OF INTEREST TO FULL QUALIFICATION

#### 1 REGISTER INTEREST

Congratulations! If you are reading this, it means you have already taken an interest in drylining. Speak to your work coach about registering for this programme.

#### 2 ATTEND ASSESSMENT DAY

We will hold an assessment day at Tyne Metropolitan College to explain the programme in detail and assess your suitability. Employers may also be present, seeking suitable candidates for work experience.

#### 3 COLLEGE TRAINING FOR TWO WEEKS

You will complete the 'Specialist Upskilling Programme (SUP) for Drylining' course. It will last for two weeks and you will earn your Health and Safety Certificate and CSCS card.

#### 4 WORK PLACEMENT FOR TWO WEEKS

After college training we will place you with an employer on-site for two weeks. You will work with experienced drywall specialists to gain practical experience.

#### 5 GUARANTEED JOB INTERVIEW

You will be guaranteed a job interview with an employer after the two weeks of work experience.

#### 6 FULL-TIME WORK AND NVQ STUDY

When you have completed the programme, you will be in a strong position to gain local employment and then an NVQ 2 in drylining.

#### 7 NVQ ACHIEVED

Fully qualified with an NVQ qualification six months later.

Fully qualified drylining specialists with an NVQ can earn £25K-£35K plus overtime.
