

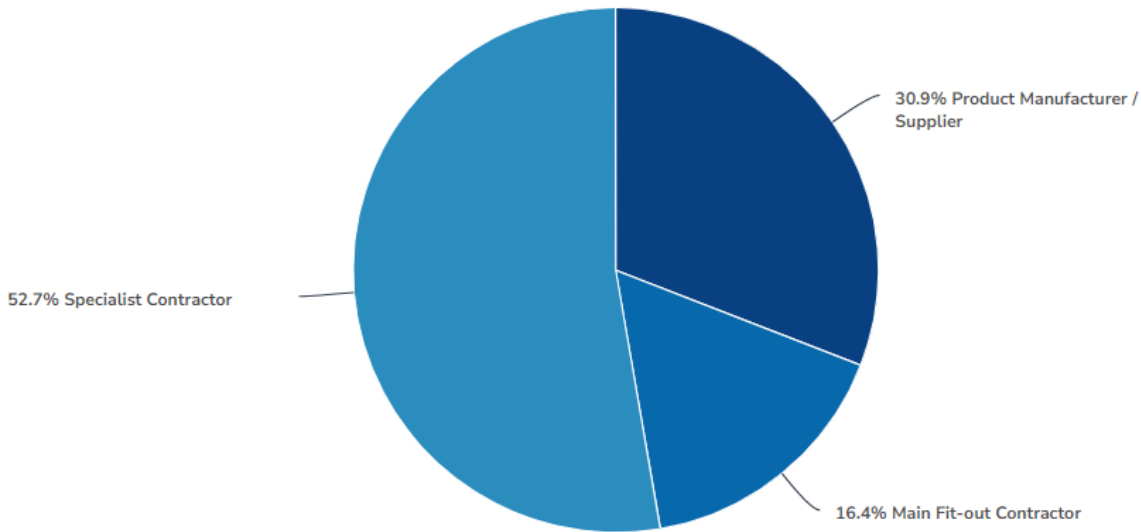

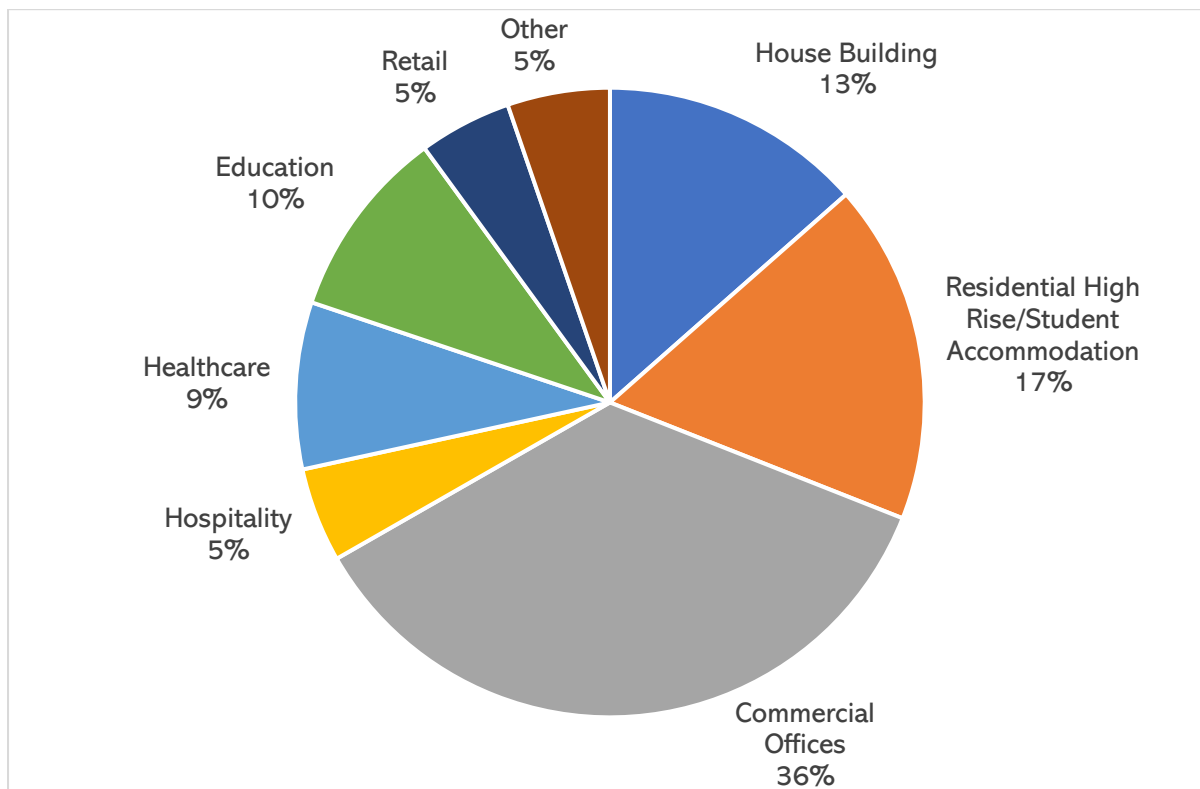

What best describes your business?

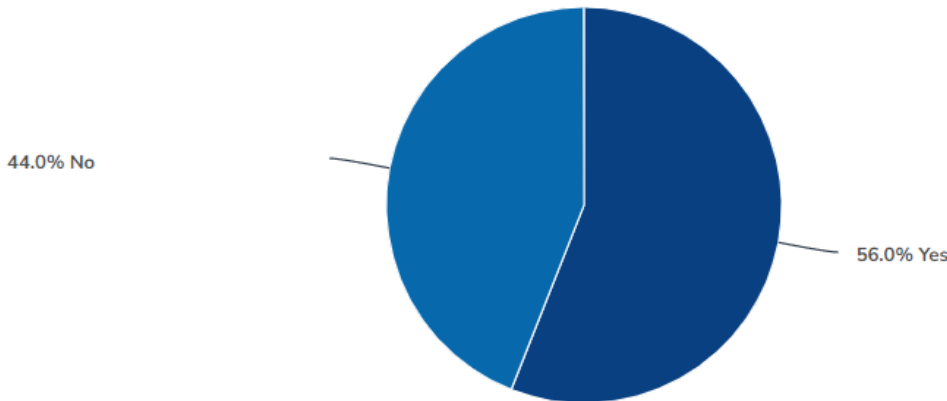


Approximately what % of your turnover relates to the following sectors?

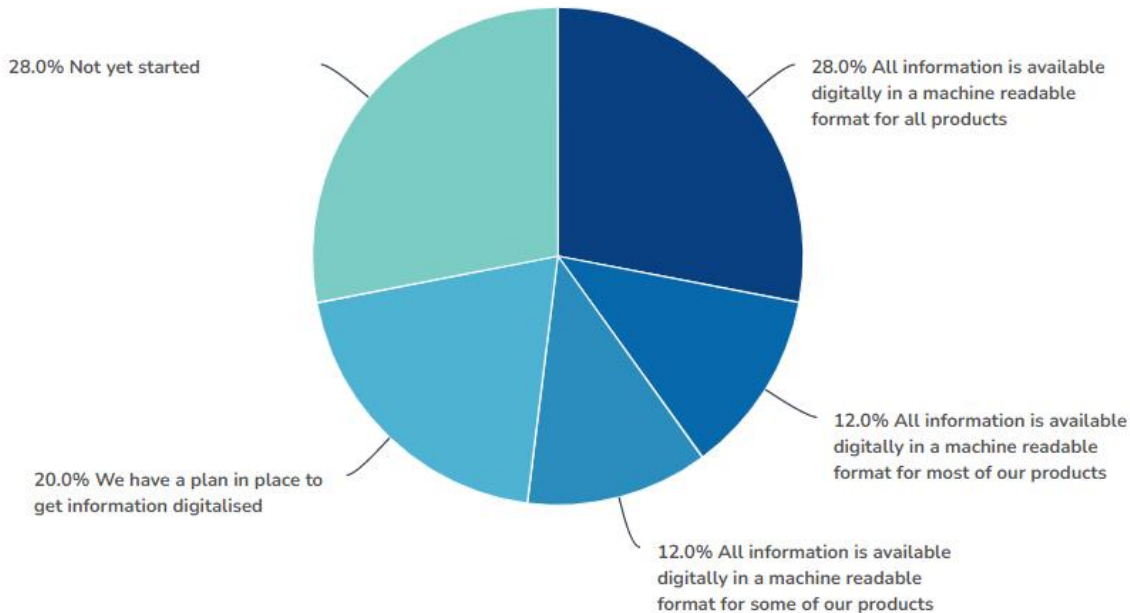

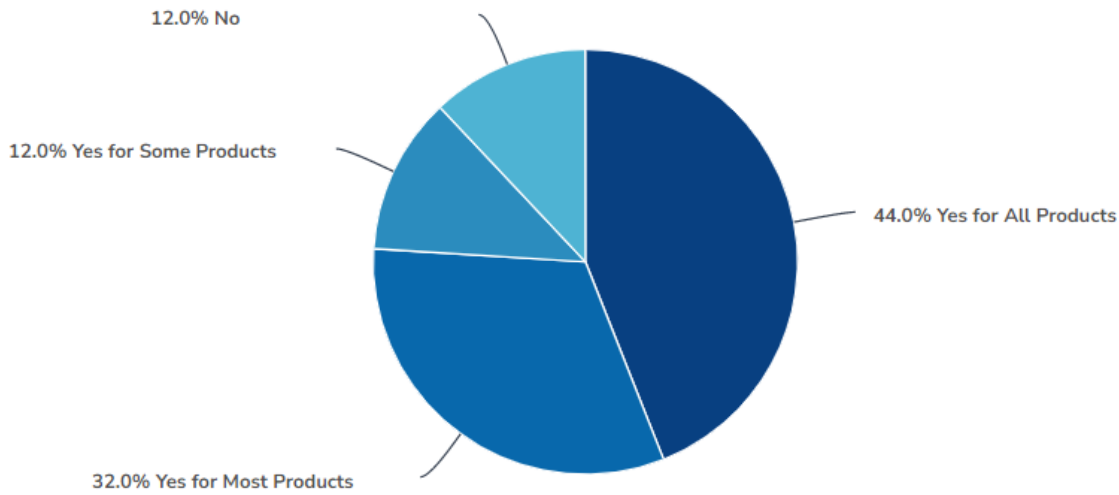


¹ Note Digital information does not necessarily mean machine-readable. Machine Readable Data is a data format that can be automatically read and processed by a computer, such as CSV, JSON, XML, CoBie etc. Machine-readable data must be structured data. For example, consider a PDF document containing tables of data. These are definitely digital but are not machine-readable because a computer would struggle to access the tabular information. The equivalent tables in a format such as a spreadsheet would be machine readable. (source Open Data Handbook)

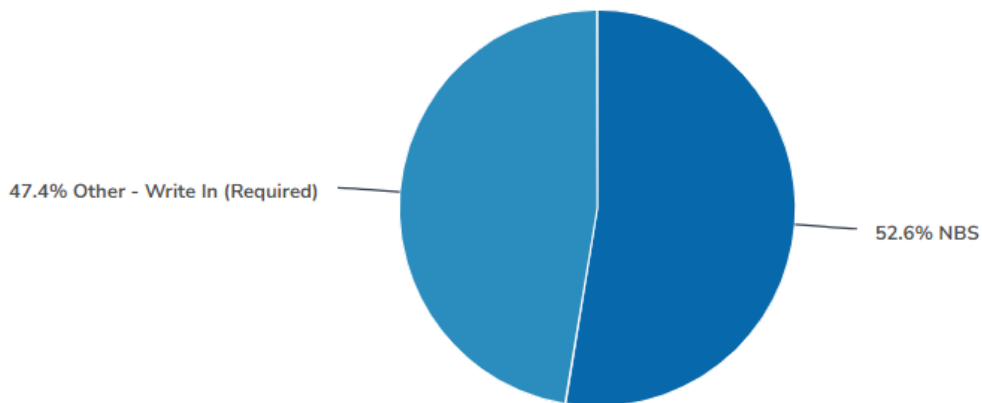


Do you have Product Data Sheets (developed from Product Data Templates) available for your products?

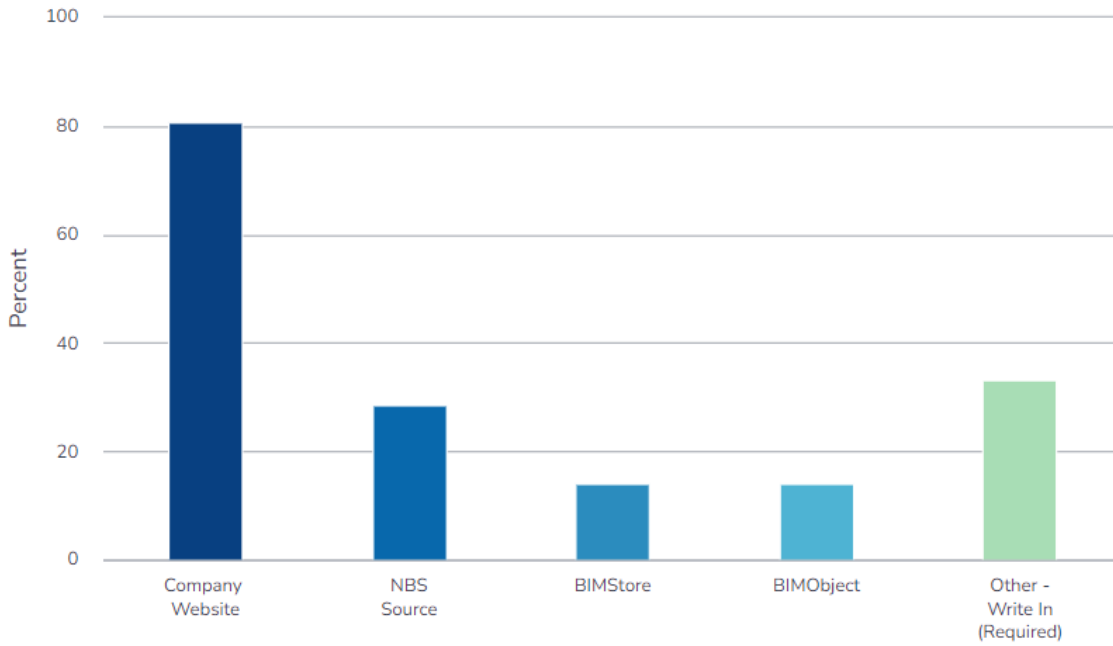

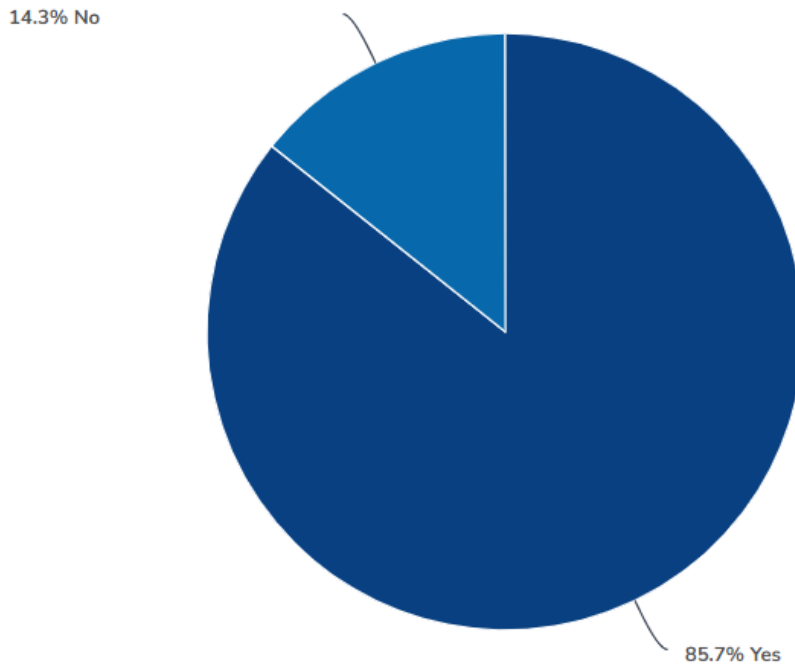

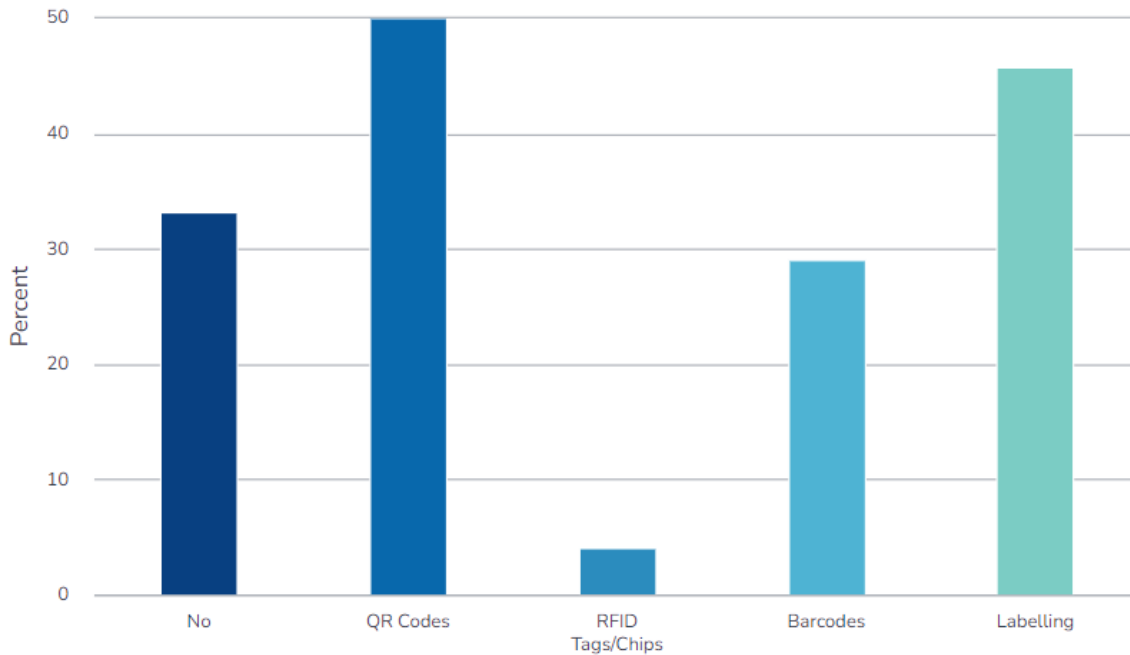
Where do you host your Product Data Sheets?



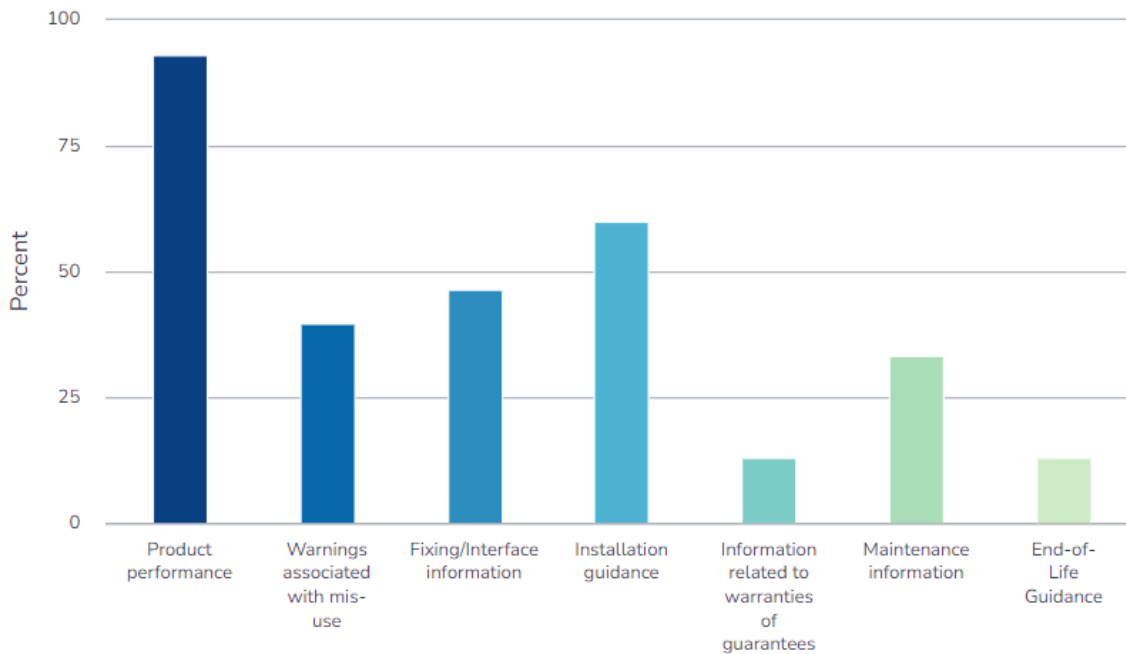

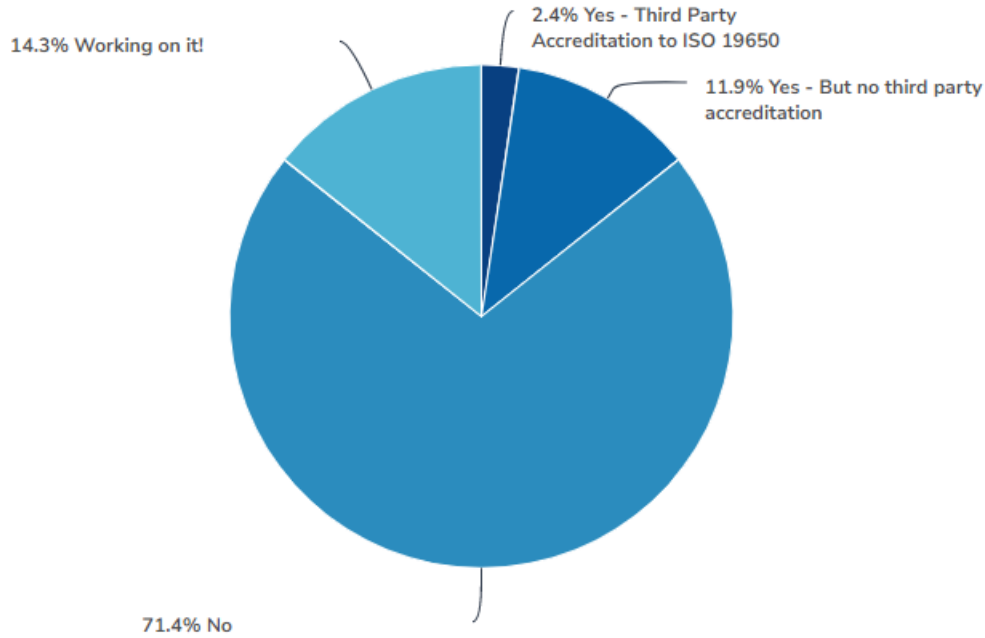

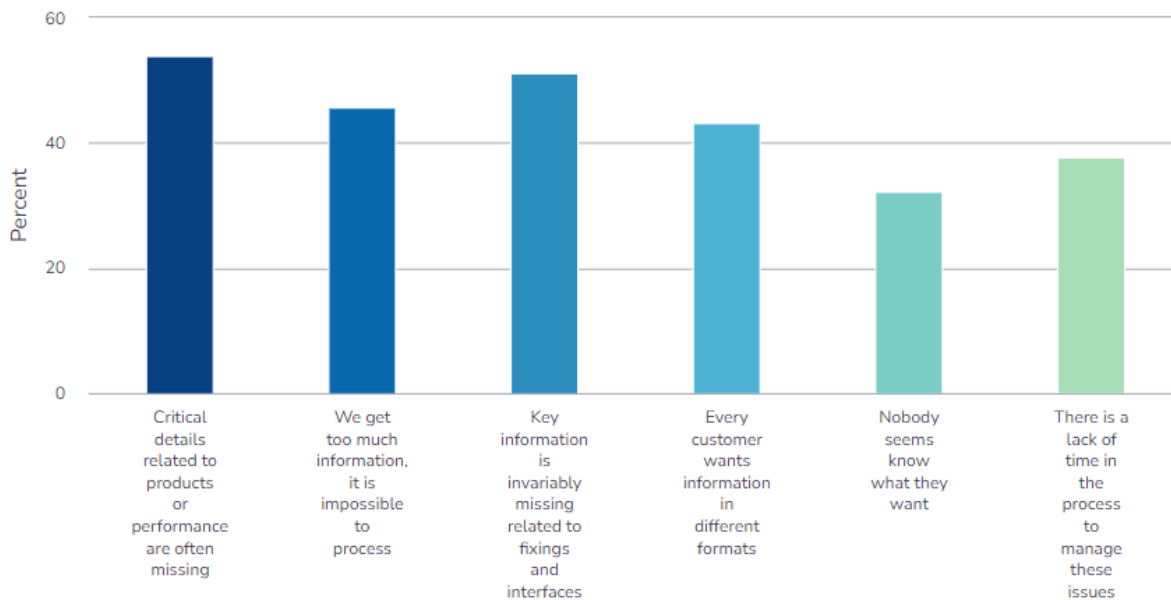

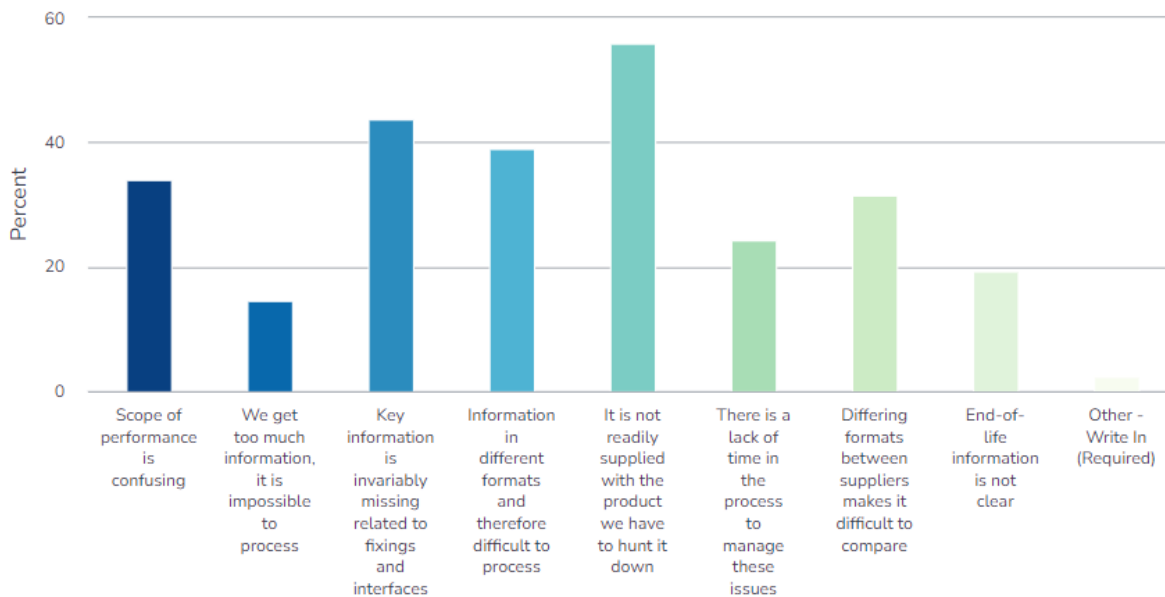
Have you got a detailed Digital Information Management Plan in place?
